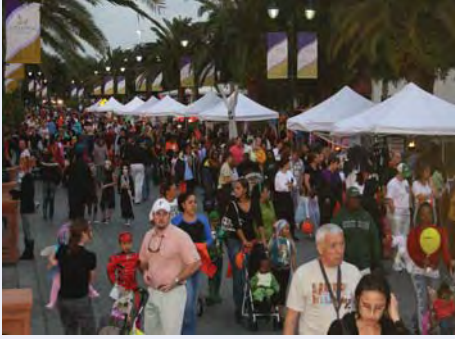
Red Hot & Boom
